



Program Components

The Place Cottage is a program for goal oriented young women between the ages of 18 – early 20's who are experiencing housing instability, aging out of foster care, or living on their own. The Cottage, modeled on sorority housing, will provide a collegial and supportive atmosphere conducive to study, building relationships, and productivity. Program staff will help residents focus on life skills, career, and education goals to reach self-sufficiency.

All Residents will meet the following program requirements:-

- Fit one of four program designations:
 - High School Student: must be at least 18 years of age, still enrolled as a student through the Forsyth County Dept. of Education. Individual plans to earn a High School diploma.
 - Plans to study for and earn GED Certificate.
 - College/Technical Degree or Certification:
 - Vocational Guidance and training: must have a verified GED or high school diploma and is seeking assistance with vocational and career training.
- Customized Success and Wellness Plan with Program Manager
- Resident must be between the ages of 18 and early 20's
- Experiencing housing insecurity

The Cottage will accommodate up tot 6 young women and the length of stay will be determined on a case-by-case basis.
